For two years Emmanuel couldn't find a school in San Francisco de Macorís. While Emmanuel is a bright, driven young man, dyslexia was keeping him from being admitted to other schools. Desperate for a place to learn and belong, Emmanuel's mom brought him to ACA. While his academic needs were beyond any programing ACA had available, we knew that he belonged with us. We would be a safe place for him to learn and grow at a pace that worked for him. In just a few short months his reading and writing has improved, his confidence is growing, and for the first time he doesn't feel different. He has teachers and friends who see him for who he really is, and he is not alone.





ACA is the place where Jwray found safety. She moved from Haiti after the recent earthquake destroyed her home. She lived through the loss of family and friends only to enter a country whose language she did not speak and whose customs she did not understand. However, in Haiti she had learned English, so ACA was a perfect option for her. Not only is she getting a great education, but she is finding spaces to process her loss and grow in her faith.

Emmanuel and Jwray's experience at ACA, (one of acceptance, growth, and transformation), is not unique to them. It is a thread that runs through the story of each student at Arbor Christian Academy as the Spirit of God moves among us.



It has been applied in 16 countries, covers more than 4,000 schools, 160,000 children, and represents the more than 18 million students in the education systems of Latin America and the Caribbean.




Dominican Republic: National Standardized Testing Scores






Each year, students in 3rd and 6th grade take national standardized tests. As the charts below demonstrate, the majority of elementary children (in both public and private sectors) are failing these exams and cannot demonstrate mastery of the educational standards.

21,000 Square Meters (5.2 acres) \$67 USD/square meter




21,000 Square Meters (5.2 acres) \$62 USD/square meter

## Purchase the Land \$500,000 USD

Land in the Dominican Republic is viewed as an inheritance. It is a treasured commodity that holds great value for families and businesses alike. However, it is more than a great financial investment in our future. The ministry that the Lord will pour out over the campus will have an eternal value as students and their families have the opportunity to know the love of Christ. Owning our own piece of property gives permanence to Arbor Christian Academy.

#### The Facts:

- To build a preschool through 6th grade campus we need 1.7 acres (7,000 square meters) of land.
- The average cost of land in San Francisco is \$71 USD per square meter.
- Upon purchase of the property, we will begin phase 2 of the campaign.






## Build Our School Campus \$2,500,000 USD

#### Our new campus will include

- A preschool building
- A 1st through 6th grade building
