For two years Emmanuel couldn't find a school in San Francisco de Macorís. While he was a bright and driven young man, dyslexia was keeping him from being admitted to other schools. Desperate for a place to learn and belong, Emmanuel's mom brought him to ACA. While his academic needs were beyond any programing ACA had available, we knew that he belonged with us. We were a safe place for him to learn and grow at a pace that worked for him. In just a few short months, Emmanuel's reading and writing improved, his confidence grew, and for the first time he didn't feel different. He had teachers and friends who saw him for who he really was, and he was not alone.





ACA is the place where Jwray found safety. She moved from Haiti after the recent earthquake destroyed her home. She lived through the loss of family and friends only to enter a country whose language she did not speak and whose customs she did not understand. However, in Haiti she had learned English, so ACA was a perfect option for her. Not only did she get a great education, but she found spaces to process her loss and grow in her faith.

Emmanuel and Jwray's experience at ACA, (one of acceptance, growth, and transformation), is not unique to them. It is a thread that runs through the story of each student at Arbor Christian Academy as the Spirit of God moves

among us. Now is the time for expansion. We need a campus of our own so that more families in San Francisco de Macorís can join Arbor's transformational community. We need you! The harvest is ripe. Join us in the work God has started.

Additionally, this space will allow us to expand our TeachBeyond partner ministries, such as Descubre Inglés and Open Schools Worldwide.

THE DESIGN



In July of 2023, a team from Engineering Ministries International (eMi) came to San Francisco de Macorís to help us design our new campus. After listening to our hopes and dreams for the future, they worked tirelessly to investigate, test, and create three campus designs. We chose a design, refined the plans together, and then eMi spent three months creating detailed architectural renderings.





























BUILDING PLAN

The construction of our campus has been divided into three phases:

- Phase 1: Infrastructure, preschool, elementary school
- Phase 2: Additional building for expanded preschool, library, computer lab and music/art/vocational classrooms
- Phase 3: Additional building for middle and high school

Phases 1 and 2 can be operated with our current programming. Phase 3 allows expansion through grade 12 at a later date.




Figure 07.1: Proposed Phases of Construction

Figura 07.1: Fases de Construcción Propuestas


